2. Hunter and Jumper Class entries close at midnight Wednesday, Sept. 21st. A penalty will apply to entries after this time.
3. Ancaster Fair Exhibitor Card must be purchased for \$10.00, except in Hunter and Jumper.
4. Exhibitors, please enter the Fairgrounds at Gate #3, from Trinity Rd.
5. Proof of \$2,000,000 LIABILITY INSURANCE IS REQUIRED when submitting all livestock entries. Without proof of insurance, livestock will not be allowed to show.
6. Stall rentals are available the night before the show at \$25/stall/day plus \$20/cleanout. Shavings are available if pre-ordered with the Fair Office. Stalls must be cleaned before departure, or the cleaning fee per stall (\$20) will be deducted from winnings.
